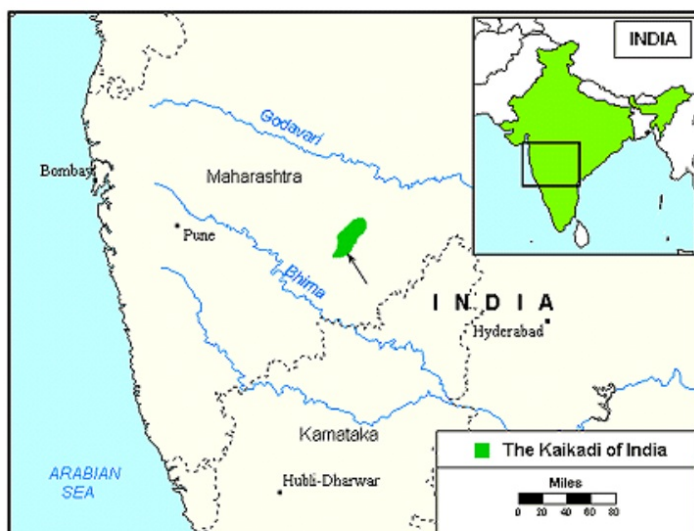

Many Kaikadi are farmers barely growing enough to survive. Farms are extremely small in size and often very fragmented. The raising of livestock, particularly horned cattle, buffalo, horses, and mules, is a central feature of the agricultural economy. Because of Hindu influence, however, these animals are used almost exclusively as beasts of burden rather than sources of meat.

. Full-time missionaries, as well as Christian materials in their native language, are necessary if the Kaikadi church is to be firmly established.

Ask the Lord of the harvest to send missionaries who will share the love of Jesus with the Kaikadi.

Pray that signs and wonders will follow the Kaikadi believers as they share Christ with their own people.

Ask God to call faithful intercessors who will daily cry out to the Lord on their behalf.
