The Gandalla people group is less than 2% evangelical, some evangelical resources are available, but there has been no active church planting among them within the past two years.

Gandallas are agriculturists and choose to live on the riverbeds close to forests. Most of them possess agricultural land. Those who have a good portion of the land cultivate rice, javar (cereals) and green dal (pulses). Tending goats and cattle are also common.

They believe that evil spirits are the causes for sicknesses. Sacrifices are believed to be powerful to keep away these evil spirits. Many in the south prefer witch doctors over modern medicine.

Pray for God to free them from this fear of evil spirits. Pray for them to know that He is the only true healer.
