The Padharia are a Scheduled Tribe, or Dalit community, meaning they're considered untouchable by Hindu society.

The majority are landless agricultural laborers, and some are commercial fishermen and trappers.

Each clan has its own leader, or headman, and each village has a "patel", who resolves disputes at the village level.

Pray for all in the Padharia community to hunger to find a savior, one who can forgive their sins, offer them assurance of eternal life, and love them. This is very different than what the gods of Hinduism offer.
