The primary religion practiced by the Pathiyan is Hinduism, the predominant religious tradition of the Indian subcontinent. There are many forms of Hinduism, each with its own deities and beliefs.

Pray that the Pathiyan people would have a chance to hear the gospel and that their hearts would be opened and ready to accept it.
