The Segidis are toddy sellers and distillers of arrack. Toddy means fermented or unfermented juice drawn from a cocoanut, palmyra, date, or any other kind of palmtree. Arrack is a spirituous liquor distilled from the fermented sap of various palms. The Segidis worship various village deities, and pērantālammas, or women who killed themselves during their husbands' lives or on their death.

Pray for the Segidi people to realize the emptiness of their village deities and to begin to see and experience the fullness of the living God.

Pray for intercessors that will daily cry out to God on behalf of the Segidi people. Pray for a church to adopt them and commit to bringing them the gospel.
