

U4theU Wall Ideas

1. Two weeks prior to your event, begin promoting the wall by reviewing and sharing these resources:
 - Challenging Mission Facts <http://www.joshuaproject.net/great-commission-statistics.php>
 - The Task Remaining <https://globalfrontiermissions.org/gfm-101-missions-course/state-of-the-world-the-task-remaining/>
2. After the wall is set-up and open to the public, here are some optional ideas:
 - Have volunteers there to answer questions and guide people in prayer.
 - Have a sign up table, with handouts on how to pray, Intercessor certificate etc.
 - If possible, have a couple of computers setup with a printer and have it open to the [joshuaproject.net](http://www.joshuaproject.net) site so people can look up specific info on a people group.
 - Have a world map so people can see where their people group is located
 - Give them a certificate with their name and the name of the people group once they sign up as an Intercessor for a particular people group.
 - Have copies of the book “Operation World” at each table <http://www.ivpress.com/operationworld/>
 - Have Prayer Post-Its ready & encourage people to complete and place them on the Wall by the people group they will pray for. (Please do not allow them to write on the wall itself.)
3. During the Wall Service or Event
 - Have the message tied into the 6,500+ UPG’S
 - Reach out to other churches inviting them to participate.
 - Have an all-night prayer vigil, focusing on Unreached People Groups
4. Follow up your event
